YOUTH ARTIST MENTORSHIP

As a **Youth Artist-Mentor**, it takes a lot of responsibility to be a role model for younger children and to maintain independent studio practice. In this 8-week program, Youth Artist-Mentors are required to devote at minimum 10 hours a week in mentoring, and 4 hours a week for in-studio practice.

Your role as a MENTOR:

- Model positive and appropriate classroom behaviors for the younger students
- Have a positive attitude, be encouraging and supportive of younger students and peers
- Assist in classroom clean-up and organization

Your role as an ARTIST:

- Be encouraging and supportive of peers
- Ability to take constructive feedback to improve
- Respect the studio space, materials, and your peer’s artwork that are in progress.
- Contribute in group discussions and critiques.
- Must be independent, responsible for working pace and progress, and be on top of making deadlines.
- Produce finished works to be exhibited at the Summer Youth Art Exhibit.
