Tours and art projects will last a total of 45 minutes – 1 hour and include an informational tour of the gallery and a talk about the artwork on display and the endangered animals of Oaxaca. The children will then choose an animal of their interest, read about it in the animal bios on display and create a drawing of the animal in its natural habitat!
