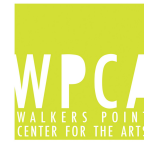

## Job Requirements

Candidate should be working towards a bachelors or masters degree in fine arts, design or a related field of study, and must be located in the Milwaukee area for the extent of the internship. Internship will require 5 – 10 hours/week depending on staff/programming need.

- Designs will include: exhibition postcards, educational flyers/brochure, logo for WPCA's SO/HO program, t-shirts
- Must be able to meet deadlines.
- Must be able to achieve the desired aesthetic laid out for promotional materials for exhibitions and events.
- Must be able to work from home with regular access to a personal computer and a recent version of the Adobe Suite.
- Must be able to meet with Membership/Marketing Coordinator, Mary Overman for regular meetings regarding assignments and deadlines.
